17 **I. Introduction**

19 States. It is produced using the L^AT_EX document preparation system. In this context, there
20 are a variety of benefits to using L^AT_EX to generate a brief in PDF format instead of using
21 Microsoft Word:

- 22
23 1. Effortless alignment of line numbers.

- 24 2. Advanced typesetting (ligatures, hyphenation, etc.) for an improved reading experi-
25 ence.
- 26 3. Complete separation of content from formatting limits distractions while drafting.
- 27 4. Heading and signature block information is specified at the beginning of the file. The
28 document template is automatically populated with case-specific information.

30 To use the template to generate a final PDF, make sure that the PDF file [BriefBkgd.pdf](#)
31 is saved in the same folder as the template file. You can alter the format of BriefBkgd.pdf
32 itself by editing the file [BriefBkgd.tex](#). The entire package of files can also be downloaded
33 from this [GitHub repository](#). To edit the template files, follow the same basic syntax rules
34 described in the [Contract Automation Using L^AT_EX](#) documentation. Dummy text follows
35 to demonstrate auto-numbering of nested headers and multi-page functionality.
